

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS FOR RETURN TO SCHOOL

Now that we are back at school, here are some details for you of what needs to happen so that all students, staff and parents are kept safe here at RPS. Understandably, as we move into the new COVID-normal, things will look and be very different from our normal school routines. Hopefully we attempt to answer the questions below:

Are parents allowed on our school site?

The short answer is a respectful 'no.' The normal friendly and welcoming atmosphere at Ranfurly needs to be different for now. The Department of Education and Training (DET) have instructed schools to be extremely careful with this, and parents must drop off children without coming onto the main school site. Our staff will be there to welcome students and help get them to class as needed.

What traffic plans does Ranfurly have for dropping off before school and picking up after school?

We will continue our Kiss N' Go for morning and afternoon as well as having all entry / exit points open.

What if I need to speak to my child's teacher?

We understand this is important, and teachers will be contactable via email or phone. If the message is urgent please call the office, and the message will be passed on.

My child only has a little 'Sniffle' can they still come to school?

In the past children have sometimes attended school with a 'slight cold' or not feeling 100%. DET has provided clear advice to schools and the community. Any child or staff member who is ill, no matter how minor it seems, should not come to school until they are completely well. Parents should also seek medical advice as required. There is no room for any school to make exceptions about this; it's in everyone's best interests.

What happens if my child becomes unwell during the school day?

As per normal, any child who becomes unwell will be sent over to the sick bay, and parents contacted to pick up. If a child presents with a runny nose or cough (cold/flu symptoms), they will also be sent to the sick bay, and parents contacted for pick up.

Will the school Canteen be open?

Yes, the Canteen will return to normal next week and will be able to order their lunches and canteen will be open for purchases during recesses.

Can children use the play equipment or share toys or sports equipment?

Yes, children will be able to access our adventure play equipment, but of course it will be important that they wash their hands after doing so. It's a similar story with sports equipment and other items used in play.

What steps will the school take to encourage 'hygiene' especially hand washing?

As we know hand washing is one of the single most important things we can do to prevent the spread of any virus, especially COVID-19. Students will be required to wash their hands at routine times every day including, before eating, after recess and lunch playtimes, after toilet breaks and any other time we feel it is necessary. Parents can support this by reinforcing the proper '20 sec' approach to washing hands before children return to school.

Questions and Answers for Return to School Cont.....

Will students also use hand Sanitiser?

Yes, we will also use hand sanitiser when we first enter the school buildings at the start of the day and when hand washing is not possible. Each classroom already has its own supply of sanitiser.

Can I keep my child at home even if their class has returned?

DET have made it clear that parents have the right to keep children at home if they want to. However, it will not be possible for the learning at home program to continue, as teachers will need to devote their time to planning and preparing for learning at school.

What if my child has a medical reason for not returning to school?

Please contact us if you believe this circumstance applies to you, so we can develop a plan for your child.

Can students use the drink taps (bubblers)?

This is a definite 'no' and all students will need to have a named drink bottle with them at school every day.

How do we access the Uniform Shop?

The process for the rest of the term will be to ring the office and make a time to come in and organise purchases or to ring the school and order over the phone.

When do we return the schools digital devices that we have had on loan since start of this term?

Devices should have already been brought back to school and if this hasn't happened can you please do so ASAP.

Is the school doing extra cleaning when the students return to school?

To ensure the safety of students and staff, an increase in the frequency of the regular cleaning beyond what is normally required, using detergent/disinfectant to wipe areas including, but not limited to:

Extended cleaning involves progressive cleaning throughout the day, with a focus on high-touch surfaces, to areas including, but not limited to: high-touch surfaces (including all entry and exit points, shared surfaces including chairs and desks, benchtops); bathrooms (including toilets & washbasins); & high-touch areas in playgrounds.

Will we have Monday Assembly?

Normal Monday assembly will be happening under the current restrictions unfortunately we are not able to have parents involved. We will be 'Live' streaming via our Facebook page for parents / families to be able to celebrate learning with us.
