We wanted to say thank you for being so flexible with the changes that we have had to make due to Covid-19 this term. It is truly amazing how people band together in key times of change and the amazing flexibility of our students, teachers and parents.

A reminder that our **2021 Prep enrolments** are now open and we are excited by the prospect of welcoming our siblings as new Prep students, and new families into our school community next year. Please remember that all future students are required to complete an enrolment. This includes all of our current families with siblings going into Prep in 2021.

A special thank you to all the parents who have assisted us to follow our Victoria Health Department and DET requirements of **parents remaining outside school grounds** other than to drop off and pick up from their car or for urgent business at the office. Thank you for ringing the office during school hours if you arrive at the front gate and need assistance. We are very happy to collect children from their classrooms and escort them to the front gate whenever it is necessary. **It is also great to see parents physical distancing** out the front of the school at the end of the day.
