



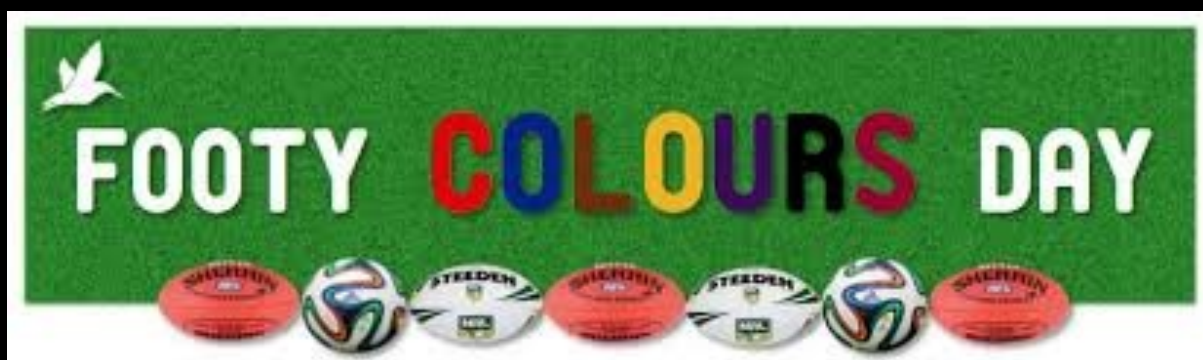

Seriously though, having our children back at school in our learning environments has been terrific, with all grades settling back into their normal routines very quickly. The students were excited to spend time with their friends and our very capable educators have loved getting back to their normal jobs.

Safety at pick up time

We are fortunate at Ranfurly to have a **supervised crossing at the front of our school**. Please make sure that students and parents use the crossing to stay safe. Students and parents are asked to use, and show good example, by using the school crossings at all times when coming to and from school.

Our 'Kiss and Go' has also proved a great success and whilst a little slow in the afternoons, having this as an option for safety has been great. At this point we intend to continue to provide this as an option into term 3. A couple of reminders though please:

- Don't forget to tell your child / children that this is where they are being collected. This helps as to many cars waiting can cause traffic slow down
- Driving at the 5km limit is vital as this means you are keeping all of us safe
- Parking is not permitted in this area but its ok to quickly hop out to buckle or unbuckle your child
- Only left turns permitted into and out of the Ranfurly site.

Parent access to site and social distancing.

Please member that COVID protocols are still in effect and it is important to practice social distancing when picking up your child ensuring that we don't have groups of people waiting at the exit points. We are asking everyone to remember that these government restrictions are planned to keep us all safe and reduce the possible transmission of COVID-19, this incudes when and how you access the school site. If for any reason you need to come to school please make an appointment via phone or email and in an emergency, calling from the car when you arrive. Thanks for understanding that we don't like this either, but we all must do our bit to stay safe.

Please Continue to Follow Ranfurly Primary School Hygiene Measures

- ✎ **BUY** an alcohol-based hand sanitiser with over 60 per cent alcohol.
- ✎ **GET** the flu shot (available April).

The school relies on your co-operation and appreciates your assistance in this matter.



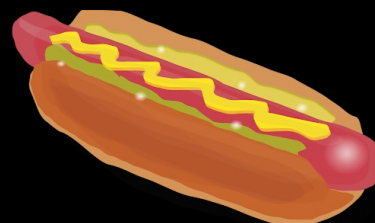
CANTEEN NEWS
