Happy reading – and remember this is a great chance to do some Christmas shopping!!!



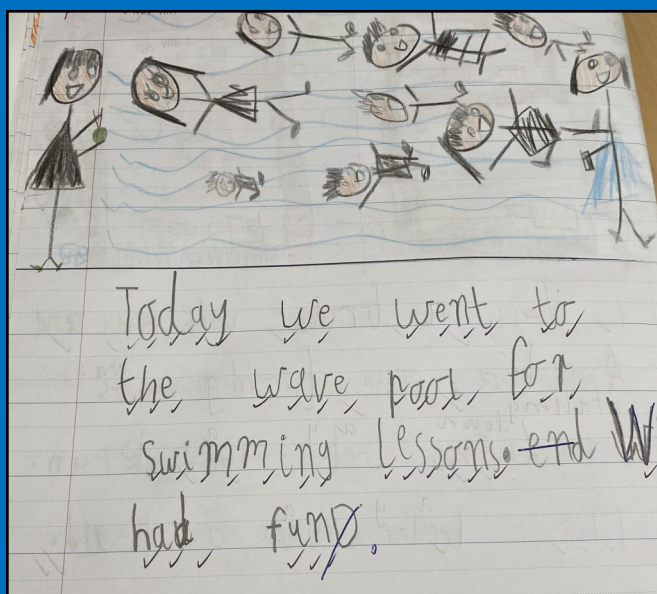
UNIFORM SHOP
