1 pkt vanilla cake mix
125 g melted butter
1 ½ cups coconut
425g tin pie apple, chopped
1 cup sultanas
300ml sour cream
1 egg
Nutmeg or cinnamon



Mix first 3 ingredients together.
Press into cake tin 20 cm Square (or similar), greased and lined.
Spread apple and sultanas over cake mix
Mix sour cream and egg together well.
Pour over the apples, sprinkle with spice.
Bake for 35 – 40 mins at 180 degrees.
