PRINCIPAL'S THOUGHTS

Returning to School in Term 4

We have all received terrific news this week that our students will have a staggered return to school starting from week 1 next term (6th October 2020). This is welcome news by many in our community as we can see an end to such significant isolation and the return to a more normal routine is happening for our children.

Ranfurly STUDENT FREE DAY on Monday 5th Oct and ALL students need to be on site Tuesday 6th

This doesn't mean we are not concerned about the risk, because we are, and we will take every step possible to make sure we keep our children, staff and parents safe.

Please make sure you are checking your **Compass** messages as we will be sending out regular updates on the return to school process.

A quick summary of the announcement is as follows;

- There will be a pupil free day on 5th Oct.
- From Tuesday 6th Oct, all students will return to on-site learning at our school.
- We will continue to have restricted access to the school by appointment only
- Our Kiss n' Go will continue and all school gates will re-open next term
- Social Distancing and wearing of masks for people over the age of 12 is still required

Digital Devices to come back

We currently have many of our school devices on loan to children to help with Home Learning (Internet Dongles, Computers and iPads). These devices are a big help to some families and are required to be returned to school at the beginning of Term 4. Your children need these devices at school to support their learning so can you please make sure they are returned. Don't forget the charge cords and battery plug .
