Thanks so Much! We want to say a very sincere and heartfelt thanks to all of our parents and carers for your support in Term 3 so far. We know that it has been really hard to spend such an extended time supporting your child/ren, and we want you to know that we really appreciate it.

One of the positives to come from this pandemic has been the strengthening of our partnership with parents, and we value this very highly. We truly hope this is one thing that we can continue to nurture, as there is no doubt it is a benefit to our students. From us to you, thank-you, thank-you, thank-you! From all of our staff, we want you to know that we think you have done an amazing job. Hang in there, and with luck, we'll soon (Week 2 in term 4) be able to take this responsibility back from you.

The Department of Education and Training (DET) has advised this week in an **update to Learning at Home**, that all schools in regional Victoria will be continuing with Remote Learning for next week (Week 10- last week of term 3) & the first week of term 4 (Monday 5 - Friday 9 October). Importantly DET announced regional schools will be returning to on-site learning from Monday 12th October—the second week of term 4. Principals have the capacity to "stagger" the students return to school during that week, however <u>all</u> Ranfurly Primary School Students will return to school on-site on Monday 12 October 10 Primary 12 October 2020. We are currently starting to work on planning for Term 4, and when we have a clear idea of the State Roadmap, we will be able to further consolidate our plans. Safety and wellbeing will certainly be key considerations in our plan.

As we have now welcomed spring, it's an important message for home and at school that it's time to dust off the hats and protect our skin from UV radiation.

Sadly, this hasn't been the year for Ranfurly school camps. We cancelled our grade 6 five-day trip to Canberra in August due to COVID-19 and this week we have had to make the very hard decision **that Camps to be held in October this year will not proceed**. We have made this important decision of cancelling because we have the highest priority for health and safety concerns for both our students and staff. **The following camps are cancelled for 2020:**

grade 5 five-day trip to Ballarat.


