CSEF (Camps, Sports & Excursion Fund)

If you have a Health Care or Pension Card that was valid as at 28 January 2025 you may be eligible to apply for CSEF.

Please call in to the office anytime between 8.00 am and 4.00 pm to fill out an application. Please bring your current card to be copied.

NB If you have received CSEF in previous years, you DO NOT need to fill out a new application unless you have a new child commencing school this year.

SCHOOL CAMPS

The CSEF is \$125.00, which WILL BE used for School Camps, unless your child will not be attending camp.

If your child is in year 4, 5 or 6, the cost is generally more than this.

We are more than happy for you to commence paying instalments for these camps now so you can avoid the last minute panic of having to find the money.
