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





BUS ZONES

Why This Matters: Bus zones are designated areas meant exclusively for school buses to safely pick up and drop off students. When these areas are blocked - whether by parked vehicles, idling cars, or unauthorized stops—it creates serious safety hazards, causes delays, and can endanger students as they enter or exit the bus.

What You Can Do:

- Do not stop or park in designated bus zones during posted times.
- Use designated pick-up/drop-off areas instead.
- Follow all signage and school staff directions during arrival and dismissal times.
- Encourage others in your household or carpool to follow these guidelines.
