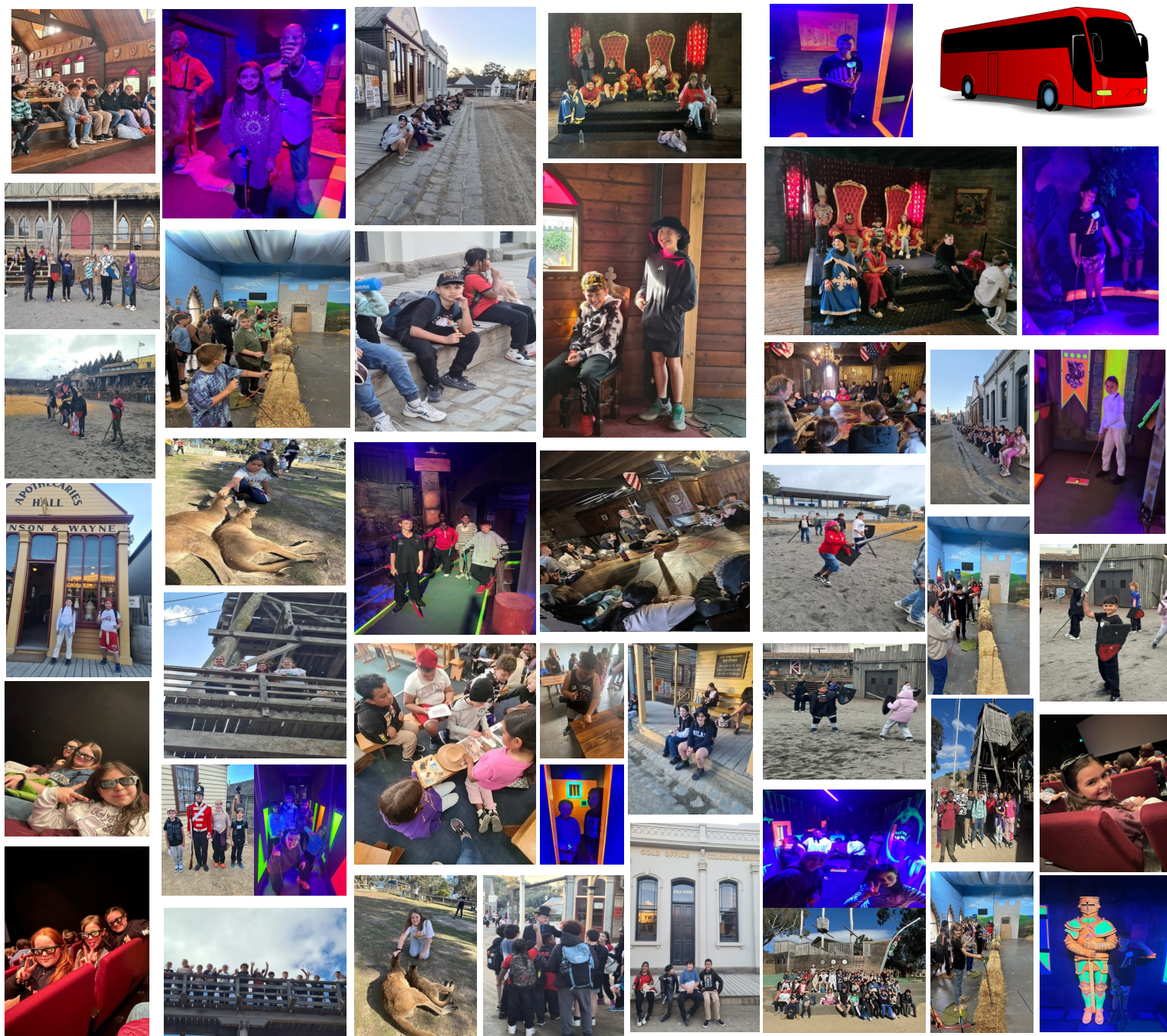

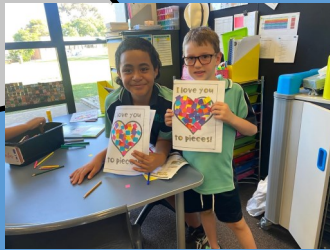

Ranfurly School Leaders

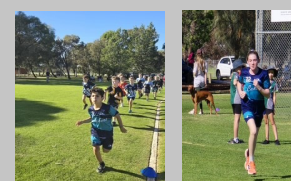

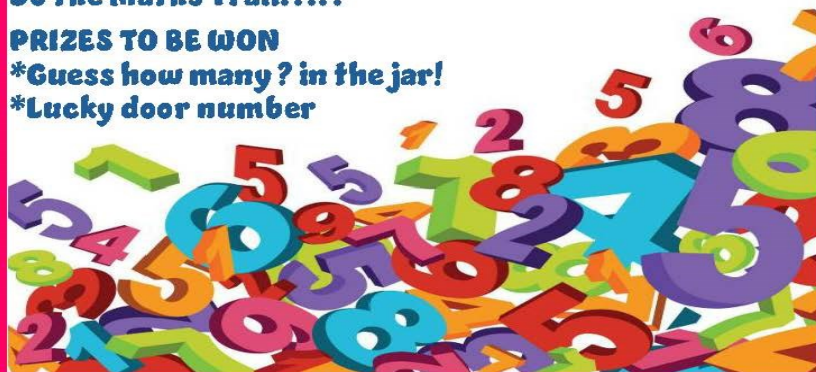
